Tuition Override Improvements

General Overview

Currently, if a Tuition Override is set, it is considered a flat rate and the student will always be billed that amount, regardless of whether the class bills flat rate, hourly, or per timeslot. This means that if the class bills hourly or by timeslot and our customer wants to bill more/less to accommodate months with 4/5 meetings, the tuition must be manually adjusted each month.

The purpose of this project is to improve the way Tuition Overrides are handled in the system by adding a setting to allow you to choose whether Tuition Overrides are to be used as a flat-rate price (maintaining current behavior) or to be based on the class billing structure (i.e., used as an hourly, timeslot, or flat-rate price depending on how the class is configured to bill).

How will this benefit me?

Allowing you to choose how tuition overrides should be handled should reduce the need to make manual adjustments each month if you bill hourly or by timeslot.

Where will I see these changes?

The new setting will only exist in the Office Portal; however, you should see the affects of this setting whenever a student is charged for their enrollment when a tuition override is in place.

What is being changed/added?

iClassPro will add a setting under SETTINGS > SETUP > CLASS SETTINGS > GENERAL CLASS SETTINGS for "Tuition Override Behavior" and allow you to choose one of two options:

- Apply Tuition Override as a flat-rate price
 - This will be the default option to maintain current behavior.
 - If enabled, the Tuition Override amount will be used as the flat-rate price for the class.
- Apply Tuition Override based on class billing structure
 - If enabled, the Tuition Override amount will be used in place of the tuition assigned to the class.
 - This means that if the class bills hourly/timeslot, the Tuition Override price will be charged per hour/timeslot. If flat-rate billing is used, then the tuition override amount will be used as the flat-rate price.

How does this work with existing settings?

This update adds a new setting that allows you to choose how Tuition Overrides are to be used when calculating the student's final base tuition price. This can either be configured as a flat-rate price (maintaining current behavior) or be based on the class billing structure (i.e., used as an hourly, timeslot, or flat-rate price depending on how the class is configured to bill).
